These above Statutes list the qualifications of, election (by primary vote - including write in election), the process of filling the vacancies of, how officers are elected and the privileges thereof during their terms in office. (Note: elected precinct committee members terms of office are for 1st Monday in January for two years. "Duly elected officers shall be considered Members of the County Central Committee for all purposes through the end of their term, or until their successor is elected, or appointed and ratified." [WY Republican Bylaws 2024, Art III, Sec 1, 1.1]

Therefore, according to State Statute and the State and County Bylaws the members of the County Central Committee are; elected at the primary vote (including the write in candidates), vacancies are filled by the Bylaws and Officers are members for the duration of their terms.

We are truly within the scope of State Statute and both sets of Bylaws for the Officers of our County Committee to vote. Anyone may read these rules for themselves.
